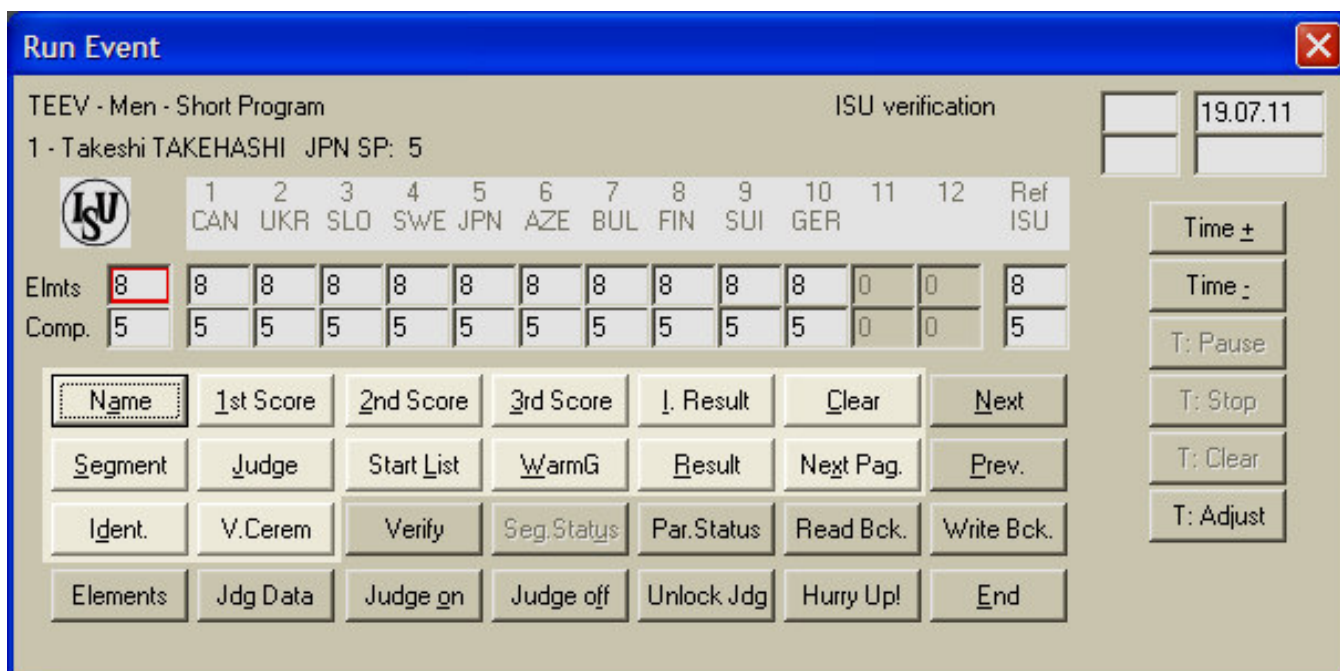


IceScoreDP

Reference Guide for Controlling the Scoreboard



Scoreboard Control Buttons:

Button	Displays
Name	Skaters Name and Club/Nation (and time)
1st Score	Technical Element Score (if disabled, program components or total score)
2nd Score	Program Components (if disabled, total score)
3rd Score	Total Score for skater
I. Result	Total Segment scores with skater's score highlighted (Next Pag. for other skaters scores.)
Clear	Blank screen (default) or user defined web page.
Segment	Event name and current segment
Judge	Then "Send All Judges" , for all officials for segment (use Next Pag. to show next 8.)
Start List	Skaters in segment by warm up groups, use Next Pag. for next group.
WarmG	Same as Start List, but may optionally not show skaters names (just a notice of Warm Up and time remaining.)
Result	Total score, same as I.Result if this is the first segment of a category (e.g. the short program.)
Next Pag.	Where there is more information to be displayed, the next page of information. Do not confuse with Next.
Ident	By default, the name of event but may be configured to display a web page.
V.Cerem	Medalists for the victory ceremony. Many options, try "Send Podium" or "Send Victory Ceremony". The latter shows all participants.

Recommended Button Use:

When	Press	Notes
Ice clean	Ident	
Start warm up	T:Clear, Time -, Start List	Use T:Adjust 4.00 after T:Clear for 4 minute warmup. Optionally use WarmG instead of Start List.
Before 1 st skater	Judge, Send All Judges, Next Pag.	Announce judges.
Skater comes onto the ice	T:Clear, Name	Ensure correct skaters name is shown in the "Run Event" window before pressing Name.
Skater first moves	Time +	Starts the scoreboard timer.
Skater stops	T:Stop	
Skater's score is ready	1st Score, 2nd Score, 3rd Score, I.Result, Result	Wait for announcer between each button press.
